Manuscripts

Manuscripts are the old books that give hand-written accounts. These were written on leaves and barks.

Inscription

Inscriptions are engraved form of writing used for various purposes. These were written on hard surfaces.

Ans → One can know what happened so many years ago through manuscripts, inscription, old objects recovered from excavation.
