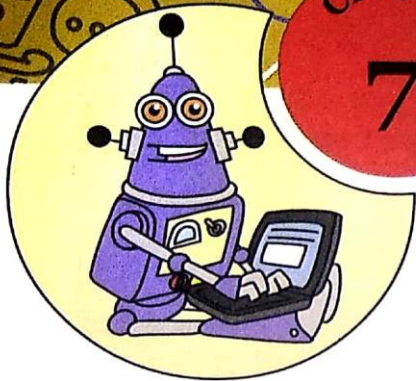

Introduction to Adobe Photoshop CC 2015

Words to Know



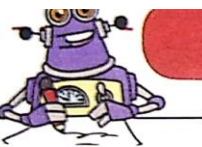
- **Tools Panel:** It is a panel that contains various tools that lets you select, edit, draw, paint and view images.
- **Color Picker:** A tool that lets you select a colour for setting the foreground and the background colours.
- **Marquee Tools:** A tool that allows you to select different portions of an image in a specific shape.
- **Lasso Tool:** A tool that allows you to select different portions of an image by drawing a freehand area.
- **Polygonal Lasso Tool:** A tool that allows you to make selections by clicking specific points around an image.
- **Magnetic Lasso Tool:** A tool that allows you to select objects by sticking the selection border to the edges of an object.
- **Magic Wand Tool:** A tool that lets you select those areas of an image which share a similar colour.
- **Quick Selection Tool:** A tool used to make quick selections over the image.
- **Crop Tool:** A tool used to discard the portions of an image that are not required.
- **Move Tool:** A tool used to drag a selected part of an image to a new location in the image.
- **Custom Shape Tool:** A tool that lets you draw a variety of preset shapes such as like flowers and grids.
- **Brush Tool:** A tool that can be used to create soft strokes of colour in images.
- **Gradient Tool:** A tool that is used to fill selected areas of an image with a blend of multiple colours.
- **Color Replacement Tool:** A tool that enables you to replace the colour of an image with the colour of the foreground.

- Photoshop is one of the most powerful image editing and creation software.
- The various components of the Photoshop work space are—Menu bar, Tools Panel, Options bar, Panels and Document Window.
- The Tools panel contains a collection of tools that lets you work with different aspects of images.
- The various categories of tools in the Tools panel include Selection tools, Painting Tools, Drawing Tools, Type Tools and Retouching Tools.
- The Selection Tools are used for selecting different portions of an image.
- The various selection tools present in the Tools panel include Marquee Tools, Lasso Tools, Magic Wand Tool, Quick Selection Tool and Crop Tool.
- The Drawing tools are used for drawing various shapes.
- The various drawing tools present in the Tools panel include Rectangle Tool, Rounded Rectangle Tool, Ellipse Tool, Polygon Tool, Line Tool and Custom Shape Tool.
- The Painting tools are used for changing the fill colour of an image.
- The various Painting tools available in Photoshop include Brush Tool, Pencil Tool, Color Replacement Tool, History Brush Tool, Paint Bucket Tool and Gradient Tool.

- (a) **The Tools panel** offers various tools that let us select, edit, draw, paint and view images. To use any tool, we can click on its icon in the Tools panel.
- (b) **The Options bar** provides options related to the tool currently selected in the Tools panel. For example, to choose the thickness of the Brush Tool selected in the Tools panel, we use the Options bar.

(2) Ans. - > The four types of Marquee Tools are:

- (i) Rectangular Marquee Tool, (ii) Elliptical Marquee Tool,
- (iii) Single Row Marquee Tool, (iv) Single Column Marquee Tool

(3) Ans. - >

(a) The **Polygonal Lasso Tool** allows us to make selections by clicking specific points around an image.

Whereas, The **Magnetic Lasso Tool** allows us to select objects by sticking the selection border to the edges of an object.

(b) The **Crop Tool** is used to discard the portions of an image that are not required.

Whereas, The **Move Tool** is used to drag a selected part of an image to a new location in the image.

(a) The **Magic Wand Tool** lets us select those areas of an image which share a similar colour.

(b) The **Gradient Tool** is used to fill selected areas with a blend of multiple colours. You can choose from the Linear, Radial, Angle, Reflected or the Diamond gradient types.

(b) The **Custom Shape Tool** lets us draw a variety of preset shapes such as flowers and grids.
